



## Proper Cleaning of Lenses & Filters Using Formula MC

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Did you know that the wrong filter cleaning solution can actually remove the precious multi-coating on your lens or filter? Many lens cleaning solutions are labeled inadequately and **can do more harm than good**. I use Formula MC – the premium cleaner on the market. The 1 ounce bottle lasts a long, long time.



Formula MC advantages:

- Multi-coated glass uses several layers of anti-reflective coating to reduce lens flare. However, these coatings tend to smear when cleaned with conventional lens cleaning agents.
- Formula MC contains special chemicals that will gently cleanse and clean your multi-coated optics. Some filters are so badly smeared by the wrong product that you may have to clean the filter twice with Formula MC to remove all the chemical residue.

More tips:

- Protect your micro fiber cleaning cloth by storing it in a small resealable polybag. Invisible grit and grime from a vest pocket or camera bag can adhere to the cloth and do serious damage to your camera optics.
- Anti-fog lens cleaners are not recommended. They leave a superfine residue coating on the lens which causes water not to form. The residue will hinder light transmission and you'll need Formula MC to remove it. If fogging is severe, I'll use it on a filter (not the lens) and clean it off after each use.
